

The Bluegrass Chapter of the Antique Motorcycle Club of America, Inc. By-Laws

As approved by the Membership August 15th 2009

Section I. Chapter Name

The name of this Chapter shall be **The Bluegrass Chapter of the Antique Motorcycle Club of America, Inc.** (hereafter referred to as The Bluegrass Chapter), a non-profit organization of the Antique Motorcycle Club of America, Inc. (AMCA).

Section II. Chapter Purpose

The purpose of the Bluegrass Chapter shall be to seek out antique, special interest motorcycles and to promote preservation and restoration of those motorcycles. The Bluegrass Chapter shall abide by the rules and regulations of the AMCA.

Section III. Chapter Membership

All Bluegrass Chapter members are required to be a member of the AMCA.

Section IV. Chapter Officers

The Bluegrass Chapter shall have a board consisting of: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and two Directors. Two officers and one director are to be elected each year to provide an overlap in terms. In addition, the Board shall assign a Newsletter Editor who will serve as a member of the Board. If a Board member cannot complete a term, the remaining Board members will select a replacement.

Officers are to be elected each September or October by the members. A quorum will consist of the members present at the meeting. Proxy voting by mail or email will be accepted.

Section V. Chapter Finances

Dues will be fifteen dollars per member based on a calendar year and five dollars for the spouse. The Board shall be required to gain approval of a majority of membership before making expenditures exceeding \$200.

Section VI. Chapter Meetings

An annual meeting will be held each September or October for the election of officers. More meetings may be held as needed; membership will be notified prior to a meeting by the chapter newsletter or mailing.

Section VII. Chapter Publication

The chapter newsletter will be published periodically as needed, one per household.
